

Apostle George William Jobe

Apostle George W. Jobe is the Founder and President of George Jobe Ministries, Inc. DBA (*Heaven on Earth International Ministries Nov.9, 1992*), *KAN Kingdom Apostolic Network Sept 1, 2007* and the *African Nations Fellowship International March 24, 2009* in Irving, Texas

George Jobe Ministries, Inc. was founded on May 29, 1992 and by December 9, 1992 was conducting business as Heaven on Earth Ministries Int'l, Inc, in the Dallas/Fort Worth area. George has served 15 years on the International Board of the Full Gospel Fellowship of Church and Ministers International serving the South Central Region, a six-state region. George also co-hosts 6 trips to Turkey, the Holy Land and Egypt. The Best of Israel will be host by Apostle George in November 5-13, 2014. George acts as the coordinator for the Fellowship web site for six year which is (www.fgfcmi.org) working with www.ReachTheWorld.com which provide customized and automated world-wide web pages for any church worldwide. George's intention with these web pages is that they are designed to help churches communicate better with their congregations and with each other. George is also served as Missions Director for the South Central Region 2009 to 2012.

George's story began on May 12, 1942 in Decatur, Texas. He was the first born of three children to Willie and Reba Jobe of Decatur, Texas. Before George graduated in May 1961, he worked in a grocery store and gas station. After graduation he managed Decatur Recreation Hall and then worked as a cabinet maker at Art Craft Mobile Home Corporation. On November 28, 1966 he started his thirty-one-and-a-half years' career as Supervisor at LTV (Vought) Aerospace Defense Corporation until he retired on May 30, 1997.

George's real story began at the age of seven when his grandmother, Mrs. Pearl Sherman, took him to the Fundamental Baptist Church in Decatur and he gave his life to Jesus Christ. However, George did not stay in church and as a young teenager began to drink, smoke and live life in the fast lane.

George met Macie Marcella Green, who also was running from God, in a bar on the North Side of Fort Worth. They were married at the Justice of the Peace in Weatherford, Texas on December 31, 1968. Their only daughter, Brandi Elizabeth, was born in Fort Worth, Texas on September 3, 1971. After Brandi was born, Macie was back in church serving God with her family at Meadowbrook Evangelistic Temple (M.E.T.) Church in the East Side of Fort Worth. On a Sunday morning in August 1972, George went to M.E.T. Church for Brandi's dedication service and God began to do a work in his life.

On August 23, 1972, a Wednesday night at about 8:30 pm, God gave George a second chance. As George made his way to the altar of the church, a light from heaven like the one Saul saw on the road to Damascus in Acts 9:3, suddenly shone around about him. In that light he saw Jesus and gave his life back to the Lord. He was received as a member of M.E.T. Church in September 1973 and he began to teach, lead the worship and serve Pastor Tony Wise. On March 7th, 1976, he was licensed to preach the Good News and he became a member of the Full Gospel Fellowship on April 8, 1976.

After serving the Wises, he served the Herbert's at M.E.T. Church until March 1992, where his first trip to the Holy Land and Heaven on Earth Ministries was formed. He was pastor of M.E.T. Church from 1993 to June 1994. In June, 1994 five families from M.E.T. Church joined Pastor Gloria Gillaspie and Steppingstone Family Church in Burleson, Texas. M.E.T. Church was sold to a Hispanic Congregation. On June 12, 1994 he began his office as a Deacon. After retiring from

Northrop Grumman (Vought) Aerospace Defense Corporation) after 31 years on May 30, 1997, George served on staff at Steppingstone Church as Assistant Pastor over the Missions/Outreach Dept. from June 1, 1997 until November 9, 1998.

The Lord gave George a new vision for Heaven on Earth Ministries when he was in the Ukraine from November 23, 1998 to December 12, 1998. God said, "I want you to be a Missionary to the Missionaries, Pastor to the Pastor, and Apostle to the Apostle to follow the divine order for the New Testament Church, according to Ephesians 4: 11-16 and I Corinthians 12:28."

Heaven on Earth Ministries began laboring together in the work of the Lord with the Full Gospel Fellowship of Churches and Ministers International. As a result of this joint laboring George became a part of the Missions Board in August 2002 for the Full Gospel Fellowship.

Seven Mountains or Seven Basic Molders of Culture:

1. Spirituality and Church

A. Pastors: Every pastor or ministry leader needs a mentor and a spiritual covering. AFNI seeks to provide this spiritual covering by giving protection, identity, and support. - 4. Government and Law:** We need Kingdom people back in government.
- 5. Media and Communication:** We need Holy Ghost people speaking true.
- 6. Arts and Entertainment:** You are called to impact your culture!
- 7. Business and Finance:** Change the marketplace & you will change the world.

Characteristics, Values, and Priorities.

1. World Missions

We believe the Great Commission can be fulfilled in our lifetime. We regularly have short-term mission trips to train, evangelize, and disciple.

2. Evangelistic Outreach

We are committed to reaching the lost and to taking our cities for Jesus Christ. We are involved in many different types of evangelistic outreaches, and we also seek to minister to the poor with food, clothing, and counseling.

3. Discipleship Training

We believe it is imperative for every believer to be disciple and trained. There is no such thing as a part-time Christian, we are all in full-time ministry, or to say it another way, we all have an assignment or project to administer. Whether through small groups, bible training centers, bible school, etc. The teaching of the word is imperative

4. Worship

We are passionate about worshipping God and experiencing His presence manifested in our midst. We use contemporary music and instruments, and encourage visible expressions of heartfelt worship such as banners and dance.

5. Prayer and Intercession

We have experienced the power of prayer and intercession, and are convinced prayer is essential to see God move and the powers of darkness defeated. We encourage intercessors to regularly lift up pastors and ministry leaders.

6. Eldership Government

We consider government of the local church by elders to be the norm in the New Testament. The pastor is the chief among elders, and is looked to as the spiritual and governmental head of the local church. Through mutual submission, this provides accountability and a protective system of checks and balances.

7. Team Ministry

We have experienced greater effectiveness by working as a team, rather than by one strong leader doing everything. We follow the pattern established by Jesus ("two by two") and continued by Paul in ministering with a team of leaders.

8. Reconciliation and Unity

We recognize God's hand in bringing reconciliation and unity among different ethnic and racial groups that have been alienated. We embrace all men as equals, and receive all Christians as brothers in the sight of God.

9. Gifts of the Spirit

We believe the Father's desire is to minister to the Body of Christ through the active use of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. These gifts are given to strengthen and edify the local church, and are a demonstration of the power of God moving among His people.

10. Five-Fold Ministry

We have witnessed the restoration of all five-fold ministry gifts in recent years. We especially affirm the validity of the *prophet and apostle*, and the tremendous blessing their ministry brings in equipping the saints.

11. Presbytery and Prophetic Ministry

We believe God speaks to His people through prophetic ministry to bring comfort, encouragement, and greater challenge. The prophetic word through presbytery identifies gifts and callings, and brings great confirmation of God's purposes to that individual or couple.

12. Apostolic Oversight

We see around the world God has risen up many strong apostolic leaders to be spiritual fathers and mentors to other pastors. The purpose of the apostle is to serve, encourage, and empower those pastors related to him. In our view, this is always based on relationship rather than structure, and is completely voluntary.

13. ANFI Governors Board (Apostolic Network). We believe in five-fold ministry: that God has given to the church apostles, prophets, pastors, teachers and evangelists to equip His Body for the work of ministry. We do not elevate any of these 5-fold ministers above the other, although we do feel that the term "apostolic network" best captures who we are and are becoming.

Components of an ANFI (Apostolic Network)

1. We have an International Worldview. We value a breadth of vision and reaching out beyond our sphere.
2. We desire a reduction of the gap between revelation and manifestation. We expect to hear God and see Him do great things.
3. We seek to be radical in our action and attitudes. We pray for integrity in all that we do.
4. We want to have a strong impact in the spiritual realm, declaring the mind and purpose of God.
5. We seek to be bold and confident in God, purpose centered and people minded.
6. We want to produce more than we consume. We pray to be exporters of blessing, training, equipping and giving.
7. We have a variety of resources.
8. We're committed to train and equip.
9. We strive to have common, consistent values.
10. We want to be pioneers, not just maintainers of tradition.

Current Objectives

1. The **ANFI Governors Board** will help you in starting a new business, church or ministry organization. Some recommended securing the services of an Attorney. Attorney will cost you a lot of money. The **ANFI Governors Board** can help you get church or ministry started and takes it to a new level.
2. Work with churches & organization in checking out ministers and ministries in other country. To provide ministries a source whereby they may continue propagating the Gospel of Jesus Christ worldwide.
3. Help ministers with their Immigration problem--(Temporary & Permanent Visa)
4. Help Churches & Organization with a Photo I. D. System (Card Printer, & PC Software)

Membership: Nomination for new members come one of two ways (1) from a current member who knows the nominee and would recommend them for membership or (2) from an application and interview process. We feel that it is extremely important to establish and maintain the highest level of integrity among ministers in ANFI. All prospective members of ANFI must read and agreed with the Prospectus.

Networking: with each other.

Creating: the framework for lasting relationships.

Keeping: up to date on current issues.

Strengthening: each other.

Establishing: structure for integrity and accountability.

Apostolic Community

An apostolic community is a community of ministries which have come together under the direction and vision of the apostle/overseer. Each ministry brings its individual gifts, vision, and resources together to be a part of a corporate vision, yet maintain there own ministry. Each member ministry benefits from the apostolic ministry of the community, as well as one another's ministry. Together we become one for the sole purpose of advancing the Kingdom of God.

The relationship to the apostle is a vertical relationship that is facilitated through the organization's leadership. Nevertheless, the apostle carries the vision and overall authority of the community. This authority should not be interpreted as dominance. Rather it should be received as Jesus' example of servant hood. When the community allows the apostle/overseer to serve them with his gifting they will benefit. As well as when the member ministries are allowed to serve in their capacity the community benefits. We see this type of ministry in Ephesians 4:1-16 and Acts 2:40-47.

It is with this attitude that those who are considering to covenant as part of this community should approach their decision. A community will only be as strong as the relationships within. Relationships must be proper, responsible, and not selfish. Proper in authority - Responsible through accountability - Not selfish when considering their individual role and resources. It takes a deep trust and love to truly operate under

this type of relationship, but when we do we will fulfill the prayer of Christ. We should be as one, even as He is one. Let us keep in mind we are here for His will and Kingdom.

Apostolic ministry is a foundational gift to the Body of Christ. With a primary concern for structure and order, apostolic ministry creates a platform for other ministry gifts to operate. APOSTOLIC MINISTRY OPERATES THROUGH APOSTOLIC STRUCTURE. The apostolic ministry has a responsibility to break, establish, and build the foundation of ministry. This does not lessen other ministry gifts, but strengthens their purpose. Each gift depends on the other to be complete. One without other will leave a gap in the overall effectiveness of ministry.
